HLTHPS006/CHCSS00070 - Assist Clients with Medication

This course provides the skills and knowledge required to prepare and provide medication to clients and to also support clients in self-administering medication. The workshop applies to aged care employees who are required to administer medication. This nationally recognised unit is sought after by individuals who are required to assist with medications in the aged care sector.

To be awarded the formal unit, the class session and workplace assessment must both be successfully completed. Following the class session, a workplace assessment takes place with a NIET assessor. Students need to be in a workplace that allows five clients to be administered five different medications, using three different modes of administration. The onsite assessment takes place in one location and in one session. Prior to the onsite visit, a workplace supervisor is required to observe a range of tasks that have been completed in the workplace. The workplace assessor must be a registered nurse or registered enrolled nurse or registered Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander health practitioner.

Before the workshop, students **must read and fully complete** a range of tasks from the workshop booklet which takes around 6 hours. You can attend just the workshop and upon successful completion you will be awarded a statement of attendance for 'Support People Taking Medication'.
